Selection criteria

The proposals will be examined by a selection committee. The criteria for selection are previous academic excellence and the future potential of the candidate. The award will be notified at the end of March 2016.

Eligibility

- Bachelor degree conferred within the last 5 years or by 31 July 2016 from a university outside of Switzerland
- Disciplines of the Bachelor and Master programs must be same and the major must be chosen from Master programs offered by the University of Bern excepting Biomedical Sciences and Medicine).
